The original of this notice should be kept by the petitioner for record purposes to demonstrate that it was authorized to employ the named aliens. The original must be presented if requested by INS.

If a worker included in this petition must depart the U.S., he or she should take a copy of this notice with him or her to facilitate return to this status during the validity of this petition. If a visa is not required, he or she should present this notice at the port of entry or pre-flight inspection office. If a visa is required, he or she should use it to obtain a new visa in the new classification before returning to the U.S.

The petitioner should file Form I-824, Application for Further Action on an Approved Application or Petition, with this office if you wish us to notify the new consulate or port of entry.
